Our Latino families seem to prefer hams.

We will probably be giving away around 40 boxes of food. We do a few more food boxes because East Amwell School lets us know about families that may need some help. Members of our church also know about needs in the community. If you know of someone who might need a Thanksgiving or Christmas food basket, please let Sue King know.

We don't do this alone. We will be getting help from Larison's Corner Church, Athletes in Action, The Women's Auxiliary of the Firehouse, a brownie troop from West Amwell, and Orlando's Restaurant is letting us put a box to collect nonperishables in their restaurant. ShopRite donates pumpkin pies. Thank you to Living Waters Lutheran Church. They donated items for our Thanksgiving Food Boxes including a complete box! One down 39 to go! I also heard that the Thursday Morning Women's Bible Study is also going to donate items to our food pantry. God is good and we can see his hand working in this ministry.
